

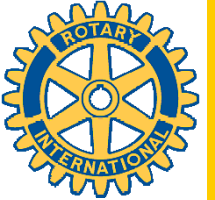
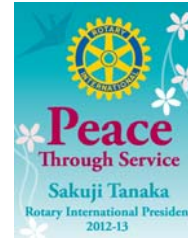

Tony Dale –“Jollyville Salamander & End. Species Act”

Today we will have the first of a two part series on issues related to endangered species and land development in Williamson County. Tony Dale is a member of the Cedar Park City Council. He runs a consulting firm advising clients on energy related matters. In 2009, the Texas Railroad Commission appointed Tony to the Board of Alternative Fuels Research Education Division. He has been serving as the council representative to a Williamson County Task Force, focusing on the Jollyville Plateau Salamander and other endangered species. He will be speaking on the status of the listing of endangered species in Williamson County as it relates to the salamander from the point of view of the Task Force on which he serves. At a subsequent meeting, a counter-point to Mr. Dale's presentation will be presented by another invited speaker.
