NW Austin Rotary Club's Partnership with Bluebonnet Trails Community Services

Today, the NW Austin Rotary Club will host about 60 guests from the Bluebonnet Trails Day Habilitation program (Enrichment Center) for a Christmas breakfast at Balcones Country Club. After a breakfast buffet, the Bethany United Methodist church bell choir will play favorite Christmas musical selections and Santa will arrive to give gifts to and to be photographed with each participant.

Located in Round Rock, the Bluebonnet Trails Enrichment Center serves adults with intellectual developmental disabilities. Participants have a variety of activities stimulating their abilities and enhancing life skills. Each year the staff says that the Rotary party is the highlight of the year for the participants and is an opportunity for them to practice social skills they have learned.

This partnership started in 1986 when the NW Austin Rotarians adopted the Enrichment Center, formerly the Hill Country Workshop, as their local community service project. Initially, Rotarians painted and fixed up the facilities as well as taking individuals to Special Olympics events and occasionally lent a hand with a major recycling contract. One Rotarian's business employed an individual through the Assisted Employment program. In 1997, the Hill Country Workshop was consolidated with other programs under Bluebonnet Trails Community Services. By that time, the contract work had been phased out and replaced by the Day Habilitation program, which serves these individuals with training and life enrichment programs. Today, the program is known as the Enrichment Center. There is no greater testimony of enrichment than what is shared between the life connection of the NW Austin Rotarians and the participants of the Enrichment Center.

In addition to Williamson County, Bluebonnet Trails serves 7 other Central Texas counties. It offers an array of mental health and intellectual developmental disabilities services to children, adolescents and adults. Infants (ages 0-3) with developmental delays or a medical condition that might cause developmental delays are served through Bluebonnet Trails' early childhood intervention (ECI) program. A few years ago the NW Austin Rotary club also donated a \$4,000 grant which was matched by the City of Georgetown United Way for equipment which can be temporarily loaned to families to help resolve mobility problems and to overcome special developmental issues. There are many other programs that help individuals with drug and alcohol abuse, PTSD, autism, crisis intervention for behavioral health issues, and disaster and trauma support following events like the Bastrop fires, hurricanes Katrina and Rita, and Marble Falls flooding.
