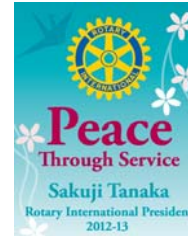

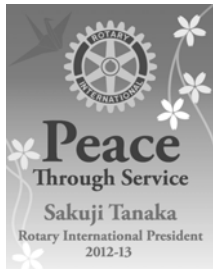

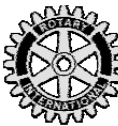

Outbound Exchange Student, Vienna, Austria

Just wanted to let NWAR know that everything has been falling into place for my next year here in Vienna. I have already learned my way around the city, began a winter wardrobe, met with my host counselor, and spoke to my school's director. I finished up our language camp just a few days ago. The camp was such a great experience, all of the inbounds got to know each other really well.
