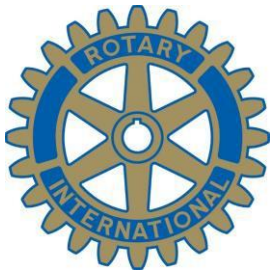

Norwich Rotary Club New Member Expectations

New members of the Norwich Rotary Club are expected to adhere to Rotary policies and to be actively engaged in club activities and committees. The following are the basic expectations of new members.

- Adhere to the 4-Way Test.
- Maintain regular attendance: Attend minimum of 60% of meetings, including make-ups.
- Serve on at least 2 club committees.
- Attend or support in some other way our club's fundraising events.
- Work on or support in some way our club's community projects.
- Make an annual contribution to the RI Foundation: We encourage you to become sustaining members (\$100 per year) and to at least help our club achieve 100% EREY (Every Rotarian Every Year making at least a \$25 contribution).
- Freshman Rotarians are encouraged to attend the District Assembly the Spring following their induction.

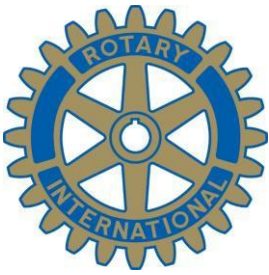
Fees: Wednesday lunch is \$15. Members who miss meetings without a makeup are charged an absence fee of \$10. Initiation fee is \$130.
