Medical Camps

Rotary club of Dar es Salaam regularly holds medical camps in underserved communities providing various interventions.

This year in collaboration with other local clubs (Kilimanjaro, Bahari, Dar es Salaam, and Ukonga), conducted a successful Medical Camp during the Ukonga Rotary Family Health Day. This event showcased the power of unity and collaboration in our mission to improve the well-being of the local community.

- The camp positively affected the lives of over 4000 beneficiaries.
- More than 50 Rotarians actively participated, with 32 from our own club.
- Approximately 20 members from other clubs supported the event.
- Over 300 enthusiastic Rotaractors from various institutions (Kairiuki, Muhimbili, KIUT, Alpha, Muhimbili, and Kwanza) demonstrated their commitment to service.
- More than 100 skilled medical personnel, including doctors, specialists, lab technicians, and immunization staff, provided their expertise and care.
