**Today is a great day:** the launch of the new grant structure of the Rotary Foundation, which is designed for us help to have an impact even more important in the world. More of our contributions to the Foundation can now be used through our district grant to finance local projects and abroad. Global grants allow us to have to extend our humanitarian reach, offer scholarships and sponsor vocational training teams - for a sustainable impact of our actions. We also have the possibility to participate in packaged grants, designed and funded by the Foundation and its strategic partners.

This year, our district will:

- support clubs projects with 34 000 US\$ allocated in district grant;
- involve each club in EVERY ROTARIAN EVERY YEAR program;
- challenge each Rotarian to give at least 100 US\$ to The Rotary Foundation;
- invite all clubs in each territory to organize a fundraising project to collect at least 150US\$ per member, before Polio World Day.

If your club is certified, you can request a district grant or a global grant or packaged alone or associated with another club certified in the world.
