Update on relief efforts

The at times tedious effort of coordinating the regional and international assistance offered is finally paying off and relief supplies are arriving in Saint Lucia. Boats with food and sleeping supplies are on their way to the island from Trinidad and Martinique and are scheduled to arrive this week and next week.

The Rotary Club of Saint Lucia and the Rotary Club of Gros Islet have agreed to use charity fund of initially \$ 6,000 to purchase food supplies like canned Mackerel, Tuna and corned beef Ovaltine powder, powdered milk and large bottles of water for distribution in the Bexon area.

Clothing can still be deposited at PP Joe's office in Castries.

All members are encouraged to participate in a food and clothing delivery to the Bexon area this weekend.
