A counseling facility is badly needed in that area. Dir. Selma was proposing the use the Rotary Bus for exactly this purpose and work the project with out strategic partners NSDC, SLPPA, Aids Alliance etc.

We are now awaiting a response to learn if the project has found approval. A brief discussion took place when this may be the case.



Club Services, Dir. Ginelle:

To date no committee meting has taken place. One challenge in this regard is a suitable venue.

Dir. Selma stated that she needed to discuss the plans for the Calabashers concert at the earliest convenient time. Rot. Andre offered his assistance and the 2 together with a Calabasher representative will proceed accordingly.
