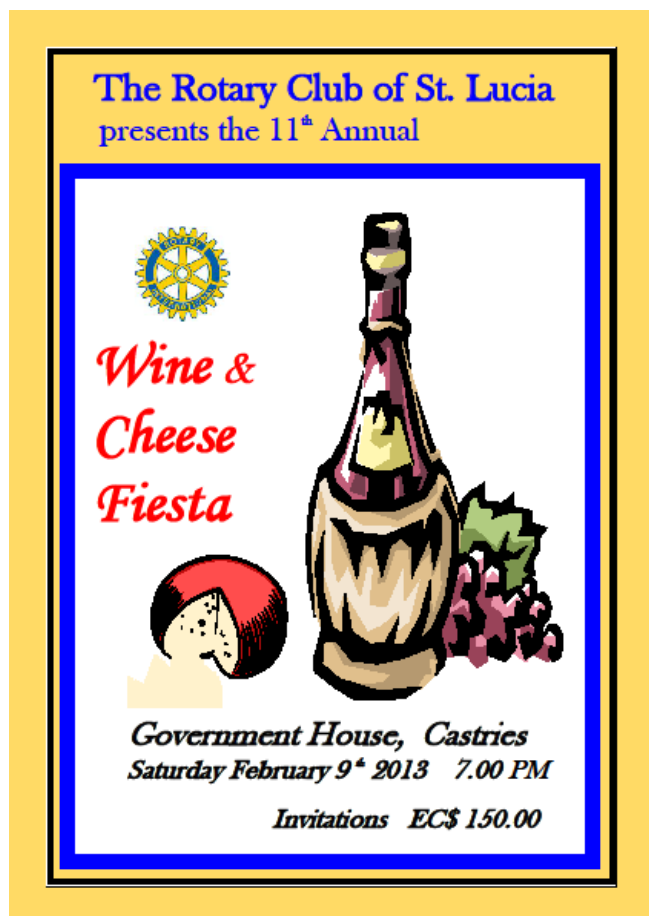
Attendance: 30 Rotarians 52%,

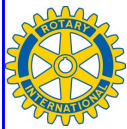

Marcus was not present and Pres. Konrad gave a brief overview of the Christmas activities.



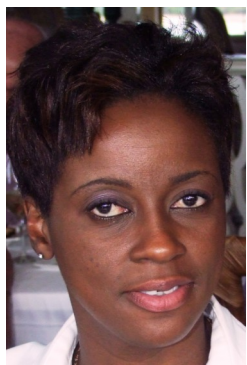

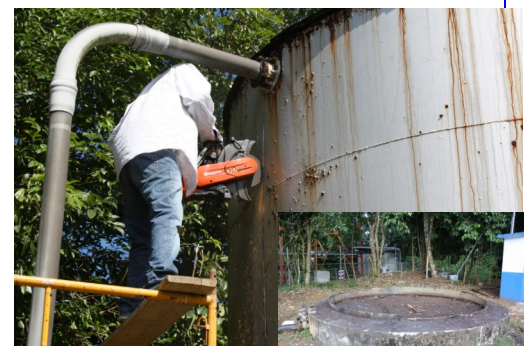
Update on Rotary 1st. Move Chess in Primary Schools
