

Business meeting — Directors reports






The Micoud Secondary School Library is almost completed. The shelves are in place.

Au Leon Wetlands. The clubs joint planning committee has met again and in accordance with the self imposed end of may deadline the 1. of possibly 2 Global Grant applications should be ready for review.

CCSS. The board has approved the expenditure for refurbishing of the bathrooms at the Castries Comprehensive Secondary School. \$10,000 out of the requested \$ 15,000 will be made available against submission of approved invoices.

Pres. Chester asked PP Malcolm to give a brief update on the Poverty Reduction Initiative.

The Rotary planning committee has met with the Development Control Authority where they received personal assurances of the DCA Director's commitment to the project.

The next step is to prepare an MOU including a business plan for the Poverty Reduction Project.

Also the charter of a Rotary Community Corps RCC is in progress. A list of potential charter members has been prepared for DG Elwin's approval.

Pres. Chester explained that Rotary has made it clear to the authorities that it is not the clubs intention to retain permanent ownership of the project. Eventually the Government or city of Castries will have to assume responsibility for the facility and maintain it. It is very important for Rotary that the authorities understand this from the outset.
