PP Malcolm's addressed the members

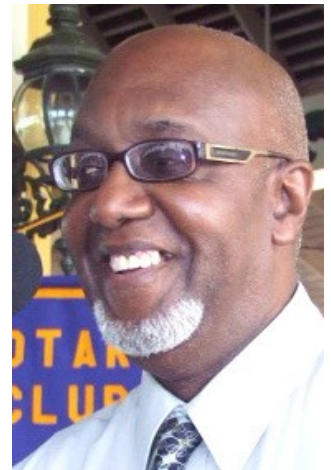

That mission includes support of Educational, Health, Humanitarian, Conflict Resolution, Water and Sanitation and other Cultural and Economic Projects and Programs ,across the world of Rotary. In his comments he touched on the early efforts dating back into the middle of the last century.

PP Malcolm appealed to all Rotarians to support the foundation in whatever means practical. In addition to cash contributions there are many other means of contributing, some going beyond our days on mother earth.

The Foundation recognizes 'couples or individuals whose combined personal or cumulative giving, has reached US\$10K' ,for which special 'crystal' recognition awards will be given.

He emphasized that it requires a district effort and every Rotarian can play his or her part by either donating personally or equally important identifying potential benefactors.

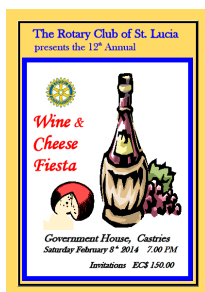
