Rotary 1st. Move Chess update



After initial difficulties with the distribution of the chess supplies to the various schools the program now appears to be on track. In some cases additional supplies had to be sent to schools and in other times equipment and manuals like a DVD player were faulty and had to be replaced.

The final count suggests that 1,717 new students in district 1, 4 and 5 will be introduced to chess this school year. Naturally every child received his or her personal chess board.
