#### **Guest Speaker Gerard Bergasse**



Mr. Bergasse is the president of the Saint Lucie Chamber of commerce.

He talked about the "EASE OF DOING BUSINESS" in Saint Lucia. Much of his presentation was referring to a World Bank Report that lists countries on how easy it is to do business in their jurisdictions.

Over recent years Saint Lucia has slipped in this ranking. Despite still being the highest ranked OECS country and also ahead of Barbados and other Caribbean Nations it is no reason to be complacent and much can be done to improve the ranking and making it easier to do business in Saint Lucia. Bergasse and the Chamber's position is that changes will only happen if the

Prime Minister subscribes to the desired changes as they relate to licensing, registrations and other processes.

To this extent consultations have taken place and a wide support from a political level as well as the civil service base seems assured. The Chamber President pointed out that of course our Caribbean neighbors like Barbados will most certainly make similar efforts. After the presentation a lively questions and answers

session developed that was eventually stopped when time did not allow for it to continue.
