The raffle donated by Rot. Keith was won by Pres. Konrad



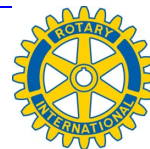

PASSING OF MR. TIMOTHY JAMES



Announcing the death of our media colleague Mr. Timothy James. Mr. James came to the media following a tour of duty with the Royal Saint Lucia Police Force and other government departments, notably the youth department. He served as head of the GIS and served as local correspondent for the then Radio Antilles, CANA, and other stations across the region. He is most remembered for being the reporter that accompanied the delegations to London for Saint Lucia's Independence Constitutional Talks and reporting back to an anxious population back in Saint Lucia. He also worked in the newsrooms of Radio Saint Lucia and HTS/Radio 100. Timothy James also served with NEMO as its first director. Timothy was a Member of the Rotary Club of Saint Lucia. He usually headed disaster preparedness and post natural disaster work. May he Rest In Peace.

Work on the Plateau water tank continues and the foundation was cast on Friday February 1, 2013 as these pictures from PP Brad confirm.

Another payment of US\$ 28,548.20 (EC\$ 77,562.60) was made to WEPCO Ltd. for construction of the concrete base slab.

After an initial delay the project is now on time and plans for the official handing over ceremony in April 2013 will be announced shortly.

Unfortunately there is now word from the supplier of a possible delay in the shipping of this manufactured tank .
