On Saturday December 15, 2012 members of the Rotary Club of Saint Lucia, the Rotaract Club of Saint Lucia and the Interact Clubs and the Forestry Department team together with ARC participants joined forces and planted over 750 trees along the Dennery River.

The activity started out with an Orientation by Forestry Officer Carl "Monty" Augustin. He gave the Rotaractors and Interactors Information on the reasons behind the project, the kind of trees to be planted and why specifically these trees. At the beginning he demonstrated on how best to plant the new trees to ensure their survival for years to come.
