

Having started a new business and struggling to afford the furnishing inventory necessary as an interior design outfit, Janelle leveraged her passion for art to 'kill 2 birds' so to speak. She began striking deals with local artists to showcase their art on consignment in her shop. This helped attract business, as well as provide a resource for local artists to gain recognition. The model was a solid one, but it wasn't until she discovered the Wichita flag, did traffic really spike.

ABODE, one of her business neighbors, was flying a, rather unknown, Wichita flag and Janelle thought it might be interesting to sell patches of the flag along with it's backstory. If you've lived in Wichita for longer than an hour, you know the viral nature of what ensured. Today there is hardly a flag pole or a front stoop without a Wichita flag and, while on the surface it may just be a flag, the impact on a city's perception has been significant.

I can say, from my own personal experience, that the Wichita flag did have an impact on me, although I didn't realize it at the time. In my mind, the sight of so many Wichita flags changed Wichita from a town people "had to go" to a place people were proud to live. This type of subtle change in perception can mean a world of difference to the young professional deciding where to call home.


