cost of the dinner, which feeds between 4 and 6 people, went up this year to just over \$80. Kim wondered what effect this increase would have on our club members' abilities to purchase enough dinners to reach our goal of "And One," adding one more dinner to last year's purchase of 60.

The great news is that our generous EWR members contributed enough donations to purchase not 61, but 75 dinners.

So while you're enjoying a delicious dinner and time to celebrate with your loved ones, take heart knowing that somewhere in our community others will be celebrating with their loved ones, thanks to EWR's commitment to service and your generosity.
