Vice President/President-elect **Fred Heismeyer** is in China:

I'm teaching in China for a joint IMBA program between Webster University and Shanghai University of finance and economics. The course is organizational behavior. I have about 60 students and teach two sections of the course. The course is taught in English, so the language can be a barrier for learning, but the students do a great job. Besides teaching I do some special projects for the program, attend Rotary and always try to take in the culture of the country.



Rotary is much like it is in the US. We meet at a Marriott Hotel. A typical meeting starts with drinks and mingling. We then move to dinner/meeting. Dinner is a three

course meal and the menu varies between western and more traditional Chinese.

The meeting starts with the ringing of the bell, the Four Way Test in both English and Chinese and then wel-

coming of visiting Rotarians and guests. Since the club is for foreigners only, the meeting has members from several different countries and usually several visitors from many countries. "Happy Money" is an important fund raising part of the club. Members and guest are encouraged to donate to tell something good that happened during the week. Between 2,000 and 3,000 RMB are raised. That equates to about \$300 - \$400 per week. The programs are much like ours. In fact last week was on Positive Leadership. The closing of the meeting is with a toast.
