

Among many other functions, his job as YSD entails supporting the Rotaract Club of Barbados [and our sister club the Rotaract Club of UWI Cave Hill] with its organizational and administrative duties, sharing wise advice to ensure that Rotaract projects and events run smoothly and providing a watchful eye and support to the members, directors and executive of our Board.

In short, for Rotaractors in this big family known as Rotary International, YSD Makonem is akin to that "big cousin" that everyone at the family function knows, loves and respects. Anyone can talk to him with ease, run a joke with him or look to him for advice and wisdom. Needless to say, if you're a Rotaractor and you have not been acquainted with Makonem, we encourage you to fix that soon!

Besides all that he is and does for the RaCOB (and other Rotaract clubs in Barbados), YSD Makonem is an exemplary Rotarian, and most recently, a recipient of the what can be deemed the most prestigious accolade for a Rotarian - the Paul Harris Fellow Recognition.

PAUL P. HARRIS is the founder of Rotary International and this recognition is named in his honour. At the end of each year our sponsor club, allows the outgoing President to recognize two persons who they believe have gone above and beyond and have displayed true service above self, to the club and the wider community with a Paul Harris Fellow Recognition.

A request for a person to be recognised as a Paul Harris Fellow can be made when USD \$1,000.00 is contributed to The Rotary Foundation. Foundation is a non-profit corporation that supports the efforts of Rotary International to achieve world understanding and peace, through international humanitarian, educational, and cultural exchange programs. This recognition may be bestowed on a Rotarian or an outstanding member of the community, who is not a Rotarian.

This, however, does not mean that The Paul Harris Fellow Recognition can be purchased.

Rotary Clubs worldwide seek to bestow the recognition upon individuals who have provided long and meritorious service to their community and who have fulfilled the ideals of Rotary International. In many cases, the Rotary Club seeking to confer the recognition makes the \$1,000.00 contribution (in the intended recipient's name) to Rotary International to continue its humanitarian work worldwide.

On the evening of July 6, 2019, The Rotary Club of Barbados deemed YSD Makonem deserving of the Paul Harris Fellow Recognition (and if it were up to us, we would too). When asked what he credited his recognition to, YSD Makonem simply stated by being the best Rotarian he could be - which meant always being ready, willing and able to serve, and by giving his time, effort and energy wherever and whenever it was needed - with the prospect of recognition being the furthest thing from his mind.

While YSD Makonem is deeply honored to have been recognized as a Paul Harris Fellow, he remains inspired yet humble and steadfastly committed to continuing to be the best Rotarian he can be, in all regards.
