On this trip she was accompanied by her Partner-in-Service, Nick. Barbados was R.I.P. Jennifer's second stop after Grenada. Upon leaving Barbados she will travel to Brazil.

Pres Jennifer had the opportunity to visit a number of projects supported by the 3 Rotary Clubs of Barbados, as well as the Rotaract Clubs and the Interact Clubs before attending a dinner held in her honour at Mahogany Ridge as a guest of the Rotary clubs in Barbados.
