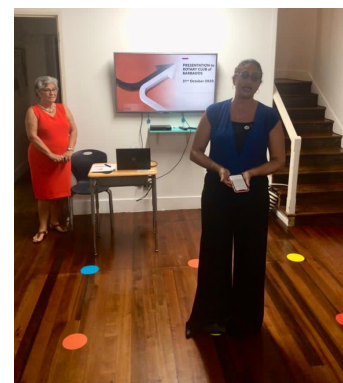


**Wine & Cheese Evening —31st October 2020**

The club's Wine & Cheese Evening was held on 31st October 2020 at the Schoolhouse for special needs.



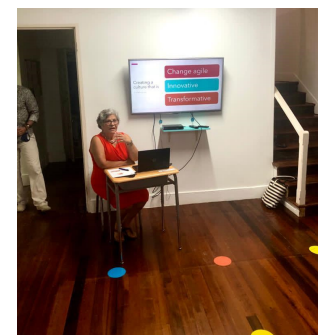
Guests for the event arrived between 6:00PM – 6:30PM with ongoing mingling for about one hour until the start of the event.
