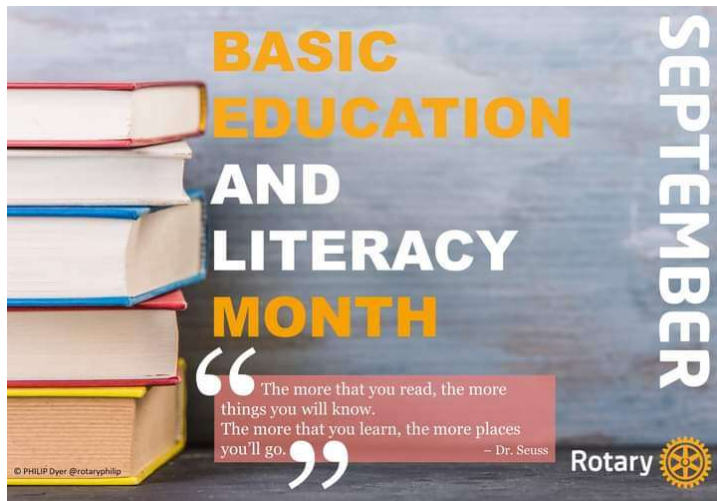

#### ADRR Scott Chandler – Group Friendship Exchange

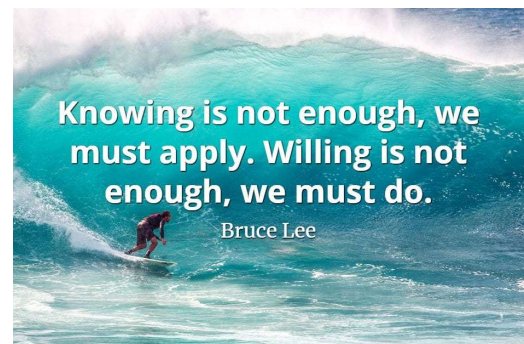
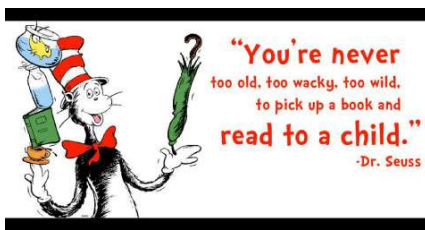
- *ADRR Scott along with 4 other Rotaractors were a part of the Group Friendship Exchange from June 29 to July 5*

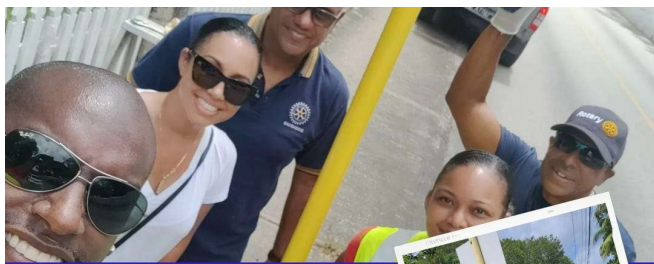
