- RTN Tracey Knight-Lloyd support of the District Dyslexia project

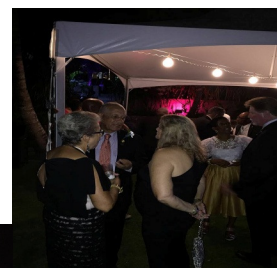
