# **RECAP OF NOVEMBER 1 2018 BUSINESS MEETING**

The Directors each gave a report of their stewardship. Director Adrian—International/Rotary Foundation had a fantastic presentation of an AED machine to the hockey club last month and will be having a few more presentations later in the year. He also reminded the Club of the upcoming regional and international Rotary forums, indicating that 21 persons from our Club have registered (inclusive of partners in service).

Director Malcolm—Community Service had his report presented by Director Adrian in his absence. He extended his thanks to all the hardworking members who helped to make the Pride of Workmanship Award ceremony the success that it was and reminded the Club of the upcoming Senior Citizens Tea Party which is carded for 3pm on December 2 2018 at Government House. All are expected to come out to lend their support and make the day an enjoyable one for our seniors. Those who intend to attend are asked to provide their vehicle license plate numbers which must be registered with Government House prior.

Director Makonem—Membership/Youth Service reminded the Club that the 3rd annual Youth Forum which included all the Youth Clubs would take place on Saturday November 3 from 9am to 2pm at UWI and the entire Club was invited to attend. He stressed that the exciting topics would include Effective Leadership and a look at Rotary's work to eradicate polio. He also said that World Interact week would begin on Monday November 5 and the Codrington School's Interact Club would be joining us on November 15 2018 when they would present on the work that they are doing. The Interact Club has already gotten a donated Christmas tree which they will be decorating at the Children's ward of the District Hospital where they will also be donating gifts. The youth clubs have received several awards (see page 3a). He also spoke about membership and asked that the classification document be updated since the membership drive depends on classifications. Then he discussed the new tee shirt design and asked members to place their orders so that the Club can be uniformed at Carols by Candle Light.
