



Water saving tips!

Barbados ranks among the driest countries in the world and our water supply is decreasing. Below are some tips we can integrate into our daily routine.

When you aren't actually using the water, give a quick flick of the wrist and turn off the tap. You can always turn it right back on again.

How many times a day do we mindlessly let the tap run? Brushing our teeth, shaving, washing our hands, rinsing the dishes, cleaning vegetables, getting a cold drink.

According to the new EPA <u>WaterSense</u> initiative, the average bathroom sink faucet flows at a rate of two gallons a minute. You can slow that flow by installing a new low-flow faucet.

You can also save up to 8 gallons of water a day simply by turning off the tap while you brush your teeth in the morning and at night. Do the same while you shave.

Remember that there are many countries in which water is a scare commodity or even nonexistent and many Rotarians around the world constantly give their time and effort to help in any way possible.


