Sergeant-at-Arms Randy along with his Partner in Service Lisa served as the MCs for the evening.

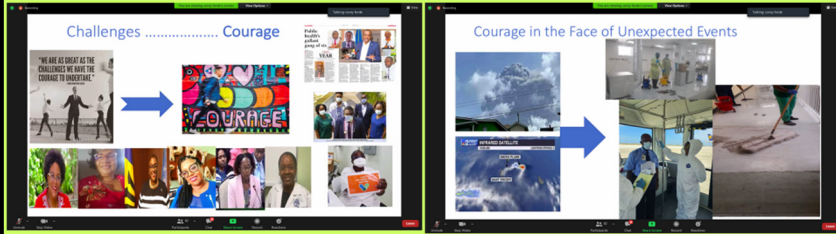
PP. Jedder Robinson gave the Invocation.

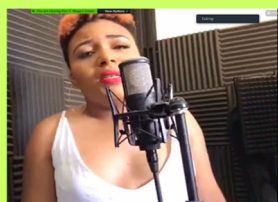

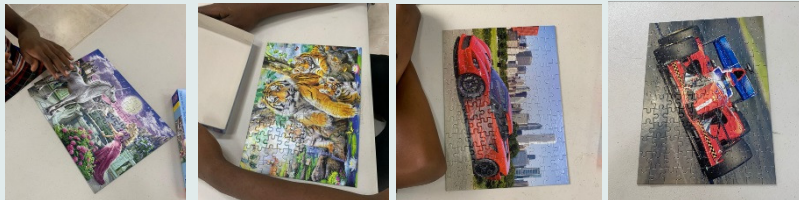
