

Summary of the Business Meeting held on June 6, 2024

President Ermine welcomed all present and thanked all those who attended the Presidents Party at Tapas Restaurant on May 30th, 2024.

After Lunch was served Directors presented their reports.

Business Reports

Community Service

Director PP David Antrobus: Attending RI Convention in Singapore: Online Report:

RCOB to complement the cost of a new US\$2800 wheelchair and associated costs. A new one to be donated to the Barbados Council of the Disabled.

International Business:

Director Neil reported on the RI Convention in beautiful Singapore at which there was good representation from Barbados clubs. He informed that the target for the Annual Fund was \$14,000.00 and to date \$14,012 was reached. He informed that Polio Plus Goal of \$1500.00 had reached a progress of 274% amounting to \$4,114 YTD and shared his Rotary Convention "Take Aways".

Polio Eradication: Only 2 Countries remain to eradicate Wild Polio, namely Afghanistan and Pakistan. A breakthrough is that the Afghanistan Government has recently authorized house to house visits. Only 5 cases reported this year and 2 cases last year when 300 million vaccinations were administered. This amounts to One Billion in the last year. India has been certified polio free. This year Rotarians around the world have raised \$30.5 million towards polio eradication. A target of \$50 million by the end of June to benefit from the Gates Foundation 2 to 1 match.

<u>Grants</u>: 1098 global grants (including to RCOB) were approved last year.

A US\$2.205 billion Foundation set for the next 2 years. The goal set this year is \$500 million. Outgoing Trustee Chair Barry Rassin made a plea for donations by the end of June.

Director Neil reported that the Southern Zones Breakfast was again well attended including many RI Past Presidents. Rotarians were encouraged to make registration for the next RI Convention in Calgary, Alberta, Canada, June 21- 25 2025.

Director Neil pinned President Ermine as the new Paul Harris Fellow +2.

Public Relations: Director Keri reported:

All goals and objectives were achieved. The NCD Project was completed on May 11, 2024.

Membership and Youth Service: Director Tamara Allman

Charles F. Broomes durable rubber band bracelet projects seeking to raise \$140.00; the RCOB to donate \$500.00 to the club's assistance to the Homeless.
