1. To promote students' resilience, emotional and social well-being
2. To ensure early identification of mental health needs
3. To offer timely access to mental health services to address social, emotional or behavioural issues
4. To promote school and life success through improved social and emotional maturity
5. To formalise referral and feedback systems between school counselors and mental health services
6. To partner with families and non-governmental organizations and social welfare agencies
7. To address social determinants of students' mental health.




