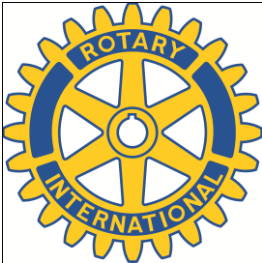

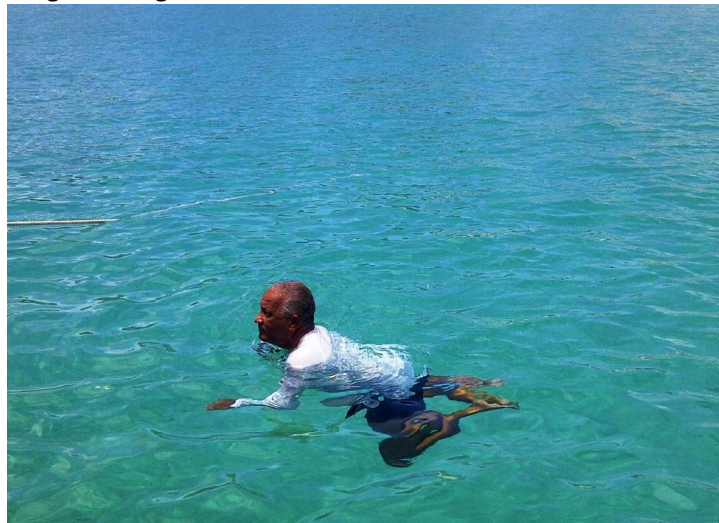

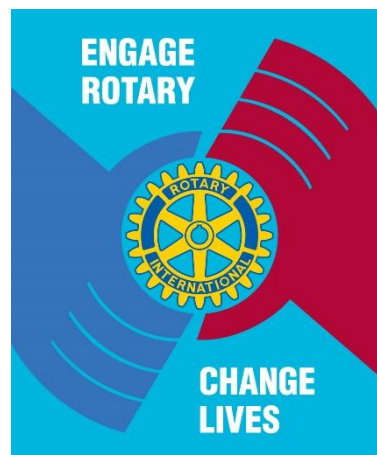
Rotary Anniversaries
