Guest Speaker, MR. JUSTICE CHRISTOPHER BLACKMAN, GCM



Mr. Justice Christopher Blackman was sworn in as a Commissioner and Chairman of the Constitutional Reform Commission on June 20, 2022, the body appointed by the Government of Barbados to consider proposals for inclusion in the Constitution of Barbados, following Barbados becoming a Republic on November 30, 2021.

He is a former non-resident Justice of Appeal of the Belize Court of Appeal, having been appointed to that post on October 1, 2014 for a term of three (3) years. Prior to that, he was a Justice of the Court of Appeal of The Bahamas, serving from March 1, 2008 to December 5, 2014. He has also served as a High Court Judge of Barbados (2003-2008) and Belize (2001-2003).

On July 12, 2018 Mr. Justice Blackman was appointed Chairman of the CARICOM Competition Commission for a five-year term; Chairman of the Employment Rights Tribunal of Barbados on August 13, 2018 for a period of 3 years to which he was reappointed in August 2021 for a further period of 3 years. On 31st March 2023 he resigned that appointment.
