**RECAP OF MEETING HELD ON AUGUST 18, 2016**

**GUEST LECTURE: SUPPORTING MENTAL HEALTH  
IN TEENAGERS**

Dr. Joanne Brathwaite Drummond MBBS consultant psychiatrist at the QEH and consultant community psychiatrist with the Psychiatric Hospital/Ministry of Health, with responsibility for the Winston Scott, Edgar Cochrane and St. Philip Polyclinic catchments and Mr. David Leacock, Director of the Psychiatric Hospital presented on mental health in children. After a comprehensive presentation, replete with statistics and information from the WHO, Dr. Brathwaite Drummond commended the Club on the Bullying project stating that bullying has a significant impact on adulthood as victims of bullying had higher rates of depression, anxiety disorders, substance abuse, failed relationships and suicide. Both Dr. Brathwaite and Mr. Leacock stressed that schools can be used as effective centres for mental health promotion and intervention.

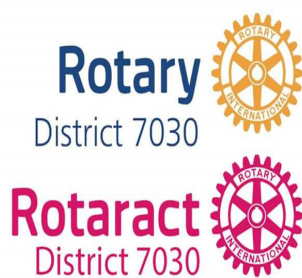

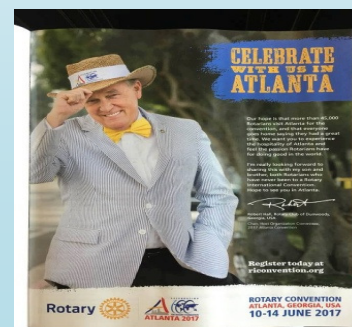
