Fellowship Meeting Feb 20

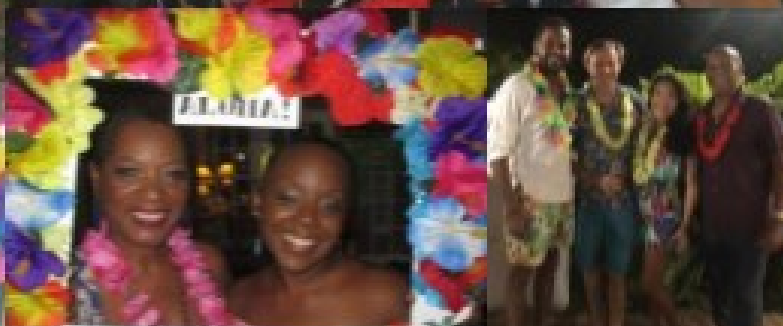

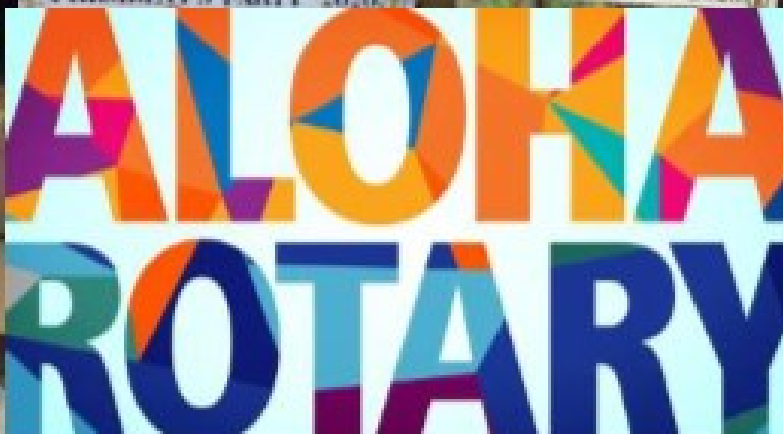


Prelude to Hawaii

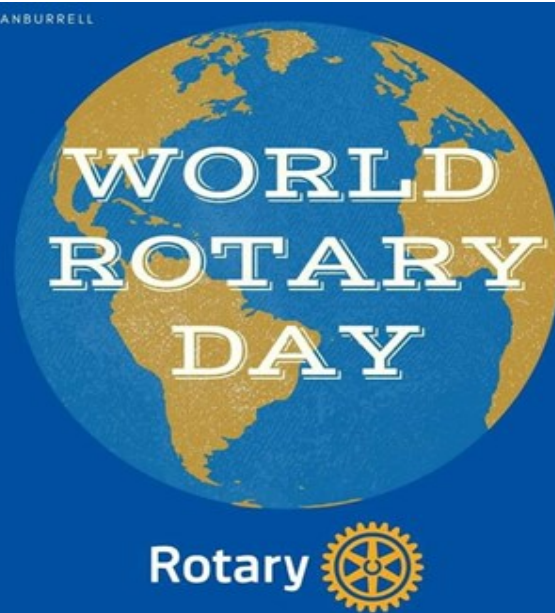
