# **Summary of the RCOB Meeting Held on August** 15th August, 2024

This was a Business Meeting which included a Toast to PP Vic as he attended his final meeting before taking up his Diplomatic position in the USA. President Arlene called the meeting to order. She invited the singing of the National Anthem which was robustly led by Rotarian Winston Warren. There was the joint reciting of the Rotary Grace followed by the Toast to the President of Barbados and the Patron of our Club

SAA Peter introduced the Visiting Rotarians and Guests.

During Lunch PP Vic was invited upstairs as he was to be honoured by a number of Toasts. (Yes, Red wine was provided for the occasion.) The Room had to be reset due to an influx of visitors for this Farewell meeting.

Summary of the Toasts which appropriately included the presence of a Toaster at the Head Table.

PDG David Edwards. He chronicled his friendship of PP Vic which had endured over 40 years. Recounting some humorous activities at a Political Meeting in September 1981 at Bay Steet.

PDG David spoke of the exploits of PP Vic as a broadcaster and initiatives' taken. He commended the work done by PP Vic since joining the Club in 1986. (Vic was President 2000-01).

#### The Response

PP Vic spoke of some of his achievements working on behalf of Our Rotary Club and the Rotary Clubs of Barbados. He also included highlights as a local broadcaster. These include:

The Shirley Caesar Concert, which was one of the most successful Gospel Concerts in Barbados

- The VOB Radiothon for Grenada in 2004. Some \$1.2 million was donated to District 7030 on the behalf of Barbados
- The 2010 Radiothon for Haiti after the earthquake. \$1.3 million was donated
- 4. The 2016 support for Haiti of \$120k by Capital Media HD
- The 1981 Visit by President Regan and the reception at Ilaro Court.

In closing PP Vic thanked the Club for providing him with the opportunity to make his contribution to Barbados and the Region.
