## Jan 23 Fellowship Meeting

Presentation by Pastor Enric Connolly



Rotarians, our task is to impact the next generation of world leaders. I believe that is attainable when we put our hearts and minds together. We can accomplish great things. Your success in the eradication of Polio globally is particularly personal to me. Together we see a World where people unite and take action to create lasting changes; in our communities, homes and in ourselves. The subject you have chosen is relevant and thought provoking and lends itself to ongoing discussion. "Men's Risk in 2020- Sexuality, Suicide and Sudden Death. "I will confess that there is a crisis, however I believe we have the capacity to find the solution. As individuals we must make a difference in the lives around us. We must add-value. We all desire to achieve, to excel, to be somebody and find ourselves struggling to identify our manhood. We are swept up in what I call the mongoose race. We feel the gravity of our responsibilities of our debt, work responsibilities, family duties and we are being squeezed internally but we project the image that we have it all together... but we continue to fill the spaces in our lives with things. We buy, we do, we achieve, we hide. There is the crisis. We have destroyed our coastal area, our coral reefs and polluted our water resources. We are about to pass on to the next generation an environmental disaster. We preside over an educational system that is archaic and bears no relevance to the need of the 2020 generation. We must take responsibility for the direction of our lives, Man's first task was responsibility; for yourself, your spouse and your children. Make a commitment to love yourself, to love GOD, to love your neighbor as yourself. Take care of your health. Make sure you have a solid Connectivity Partner. Life Is a journey and there will be obstacles along the way. Do not allow the past to control your present. The Wise man Solomon reminds us that there are seasons; we can't change them, but we can recognize and respond appropriately. Practice the secret of adjustment as we get older, we become frustrated with life and some go into states of depression, even suicide, from which 1 person dies every 40 secs. Health issues show up. Sexual prowess moves from 3am to 6am and becomes a secret... It is critical to have regular prostate and blood pressure checks. The career challenges, retirement looms, the fear the unknown. Look in the mirror, who is that man?

Take time to Pause, Reflect, Review, Revise. Give GOD a space in your life.

## Would you donate a Kidney?

Kidney failure is taking a toll on many Barbadians who have to set aside up to 4 hours three times a week for dialysis treatment. This also impacts their families, friends and work colleagues. One year of dialysis can cost over US\$75,000 according to information from the U.S. Renal Data System. With over 300 persons on dialysis, the cost to our national health system is astounding.

There is an option. **Kidney transplant!**

However, only transplants involving living donors are presently permitted in Barbados. Thankfully, the Government of Barbados will soon be introducing legislation to allow organ donation after death. While this is welcomed, Barbadians must be informed about the life-saving nature of organ donation and how they can become a donor.

The Rotary Club of Barbados will be playing its part through an awareness initiative. The campaign is being supported by the team from Red Advertising and will be done in collaboration with the QEH and the Ministry of Health. Our Club will be able to draw on similar awareness campaigns run by Rotary clubs around the world. An example from Rotary in India is shown below.

Our guests on Thursday, February 13 will be Dr. Margaret O'Shea, transplant surgeon, and Dr. Nerissa Jurawan, nephrologist at the QEH. Dr. Jurawan will speak to us about the programme at the QEH. We look forward to your attendance.
