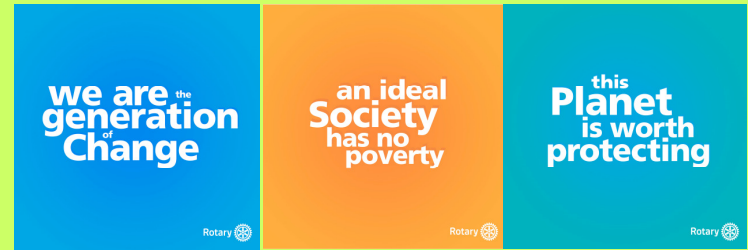
In just examining these pictures, the talent from those young participants is clearly evident and should be encouraged as they continue to grow from strength to strength.

Childhood Obesity Prevention has a nutrition component, but to have nutritious food it is important that it is available and it is safe to consume.

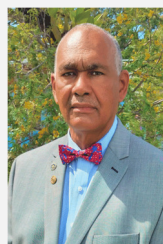
Four speakers from around the world will share knowledge and experience with Rotarians and the general public on planting and growing of safe and healthy foods.
