- Booth stalls are 10' x 10'.
- Vendors can reserve multiple booths
- The market is limited to 24 stalls
- Each stall area is \$50
- Vendors must supply their own tents, chairs & tables.
- Areas are assigned in the order the booth fees are received.
- Setup is 9:00 am
- Breakdown is after the fair closes @ 4:00 pm

Note: Food vendors cannot serve foods that compete with the Rotary Hamburger – Frankfurter grill, which includes Sodas. Ice Tea, water and chips.

- There is also an opportunity to be involved in the "1820 Street", where vendors show off how their stand would look in the early 1800s (these stalls all have priority placement at the front of the Market Area). Please ask for more information.
