

## PROJECT GBI Rx FINAL REPORT

Early in the 2020-2021 Rotary year, as Treasurer of the Rotary Club of Miami and our Foundation, I thought it would be a great idea to finally try and master the Global Grant process one more time. Previous attempts did not fare well, and even small District grants were dismissed because it was just easier for us to self-fund.

In reaching out to the District Foundation Chair, PDG Alan Cohn, I learned that it had always been his vision to do a Global Grant within our District 6990 with our 5 Bahamian Rotary Clubs. We are one of the few Rotary Districts that have this "international" makeup. On August 13<sup>th</sup>, I sent an email to the GBI Clubs asking about doing an international grant within our own District. Five days later I heard back from Lisbeth Knowles who I would later learn had already greatly proven her abilities to help coordinate Bahamas Disaster Relief following Hurricane Dorian. She suggested a project to help the Rand Memorial Hospital in Freeport. This hospital, the only one on the island of Grand Bahama to serve the health needs of the island, the Abacos and even Bimini, had been severely flooded by Hurricane Dorian.

The Rotary Club of Miami has a rich, lengthy medical history. Our Club was founded in 1917 by Miami's first physician, Dr. James Jackson. On August 21, I responded to Ms. Knowles that this sounded like a suitable project that I thought our Club and the District could get interested in. I projected a possible budget of \$150,000. That same day, DG Peter Verbeeck also said he liked the idea of a Global Grant for the Rand Hospital. Then, PDG Alan Cohn advised that we couldn't add to the District Grants of this year as they had already been submitted to R.I. When I contacted R.I. for further information and guidance on Global Grant procedures, etc., I was also told that COVID-19 projects had pretty much overwhelmed the pool of available matching funds. So now what do we do?

On 8/25 we received a "wish list" of items most needed by the Rand Hospital that totaled \$829,000! On 8/31, DG Verbeeck said he would give our project his full support. On 9/8 after a Miami Rotary Board meeting, I advised that Miami Rotary would "kick in a goodly sum" thinking now in terms of a project of \$200,000. Sometime around early October, I created the name "Project GBI Rx". On 10/11, not seeing any other way to get anything done quickly, I bravely proposed that we proceed without any R.I. or District Designated Funds. Instead, the Rotary Club of Miami would pick up that end & match up to \$100,000 of project donations. PDG Alan asked that I write a project "synopsis". Not being able spell that, I responded with a project "outline" using as much Rotary "grant jargon" as possible to make the project look like a legitimate Rotary grant.

On 10/12, I asked Barbara Gobbi if Lisbeth Knowles could announce our project on the District Zoom social that night. On 10/15, we started to develop a project flyer to use to promote "GBI Rx". That was completed on 10/19. After writing on 10/20 about getting an article in the online November District newsletter to promote Project GBI Rx, I learned the true purpose of the District newsletter was to publish articles about the District and not any particular clubs to avoid any hints of favoritism. Well, so much for the concept of this being a "district project"! However, Barbara did eventually see the light and has since been of great assistance.

Next came our first donation on 10/23 from a wonderful Rotarian, Maria Kesti of the Perrine, Cutler Ridge, too many Names Club. Together with some other donations, we had our first deposit of \$2,850 on 10/26. With almost all of the donations from Miami Rotary, at the end of October, we had reached \$4,072. By adding PayPal, we ended November with \$11,268 in the bank. What an uphill struggle!

But, the donation momentum thankfully continued in December despite COVID, hard economic times, holiday spending, you name it. The word was truly starting to get out. We started getting contributions from around the country & around the world. With our goal of \$100,000, we were particularly grateful to Pat Mulvihill and the Rotary District 6970 Disaster Assistance Fund who had already planned to donate \$9,500 for hospital equipment. We convinced them to send us the funds to be put toward the match. However, an analysis of donations through 12/15 revealed that out of \$31,000, only 15% had come from District 6990 Clubs and Rotarians other than Miami and GBI. So, we decided on 12/21 to add an additional incentive of another \$25,000 to match all District 6990 donations to get this project done! In the next few days, we received \$10,400 of money toward that extra \$25,000 match including \$5,000 from District 6990 and \$500 from DG Verbeeck. By Christmas Eve, we had deposited \$44,483. The next donations were truly epic!

The estate of a former Miami Rotarian, Dick Mead, donated \$2,000. The Moore Bahamas Foundation wired us \$5,000. Two Rotarians from the Rotary Club of Ft. Lauderdale- Cypress Creek each donated \$500 along with a Rotarian from the Rotary Club of Hollywood who sent \$500 in memory of her husband. Then, and this is truly what makes going to the Post Office so exciting, on 1/15 we received \$7,500 from the Lincoln, NE Woman's Club! The Rotary Club of Seward, NE had already earlier donated \$500 together with \$500 from 2 other Seward Rotarians. Those 2 Rotarians knew and contacted someone in that Woman's Club! Isn't life wonderful! That miraculously brought us up to \$60,723 on deposit in Miami by mid January!

Then it gets even better! A Norwegian energy company, Equinor, with business interests in the Bahamas made known their intention to add \$100,000 to our cause. The Rotary Club of Plantation sent \$1000, and Hallandale-Aventura sent in \$500 bringing us to \$162,273. Then, Thursday, 1/21 would prove to be a momentous day. The program speaker at Miami Rotary was Christine van der Linde of Grand Bahama. She presented her poignant personal story of Hurricane Dorian and showed actual storm videos. Our Club, already the sponsor of the \$125,000 match and having already made personal donations in the amount of \$5,155, proceeded to generously donate Happy\$ that eventually added up to another \$3,585.

As February began, we received \$1000 from Ft. Lauderdale-Cypress Creek, \$2500 from Miami-Brickell and \$1000 from Coconut Grove. Toward the end of February, after contact with the Rotary Club of John Knox Village, we received \$4900 from their Club & another \$1770 from individual members taking us to \$181,428.

In March, our PDG Robin Shelley contacted PDG Betsy Owen of the Rotary Club of Delray Beach. With the wonders of Zoom, Christine did her presentation again bringing in another \$2,400. We finished March the way we began the campaign with another \$1000 from our beloved Perrine-Cutler Ridge-Palmetto Bay taking us to \$184,828 in collections.

April saw a wonderful donation of \$1500 from the Rotary Club of Delray Beach and receipt of \$100 to replace a lost check from that incredible 1/21 RCOM Happy\$ event.

On May 14<sup>th</sup>, we received an envelope of 7 checks from members of the Rotary Club of Plantation totaling \$1050 bringing us up to \$187,478. Then, after our May 20<sup>th</sup> Zoom Lunch meeting with guest speaker PRIP Barry Rassin saying nice things about our Project GBI Rx, we received Happy\$ of \$430 from Miami Rotarians & guests. That brought us to \$187,858. In appreciation, I pledged to match the \$430 which ended up becoming \$542 taking us to \$188,450 on this side of the Gulfstream.

In June, we saw donations of \$770 from members of the Rotary Club of Plantation. With a final donation of \$500 from the Rotary Club of Coral Springs-Parkland, our collections totaled \$189,720.

All this time, the Bahamian Rotarians were also busy collecting funds. Their first donation was \$400 from Christine van der Linde, Past President of the Rotary Club of Grand Bahama. In December, they received \$39,000 from the Rotary Disaster Relief Committee of District 7020. Rotarian Mike Stafford from the RC of Freeport & friends also sent in \$200. BWA, a Bahamian grocery company sent in a generous \$5,000. Another Rotarian, Donald Glass of the RC of Lucaya sent \$60, and the Rotary Club of Grand Bahama gave \$1000. With a donation of \$250 from the Rotaract Club of Freeport and \$80 from the Rotaract Club of Eight Mile Rock, their total collections on their side of the Gulfstream came to \$47,600.

### **SOURCES OF FUNDS RECAP**

Putting the two together, we raised \$237,320.

Here is a quick analysis of just where all of this money came from:

District 6990 & Its Rotary Clubs: 17 Clubs in our District & the District contributed \$29,900 or 12.6%

District 6990 Individual Rotarians: 30 Rotarians gave \$9,190 or 3.87%

Miami Rotarians: Even though our Club was putting up the match of \$125,000, there were 13 donations that totaled \$4655 or 1.96%

Grand Bahama Clubs & Rotarians: We collected \$501 plus they collected \$3,600 = \$4101 or 1.73%

Bahamas Rotary District 7020 & a Bahamian grocery company gave \$44,000 or 18.54%

Friends of GBI gave \$20,895 plus \$100,000 from Equinor Energy = \$120,895 or 50.942%

Other Florida & U.S. Rotary Clubs: 11 donations amounted to \$14,550 or 6.13%

International Rotary Clubs & Rotarians: 4 donations for a total of \$2362 or just under 1%

At the 1/21/21 virtual meeting of the Rotary Club of Miami after hearing Christine van der Linde speak about the ravages of the hurricane, 26 people at that meeting gave \$3,585 or 1.51%

At another RCOM meeting on 5/20/21 at which Past International President Barry Rassin spoke, another 10 donations came to \$972

With the match of \$125,000 from the Rotary Club of Miami Foundation, we raised \$362,320 total!

### **DISPOSITION OF FUNDS RECAP**

So what was done with all of this money? Well, remember the generous \$9,500 from the RC of Jacksonville North & the District 6970 Disaster Fund? That purchased a 40' container of slightly used hospital equipment from S.O.S. International in Kentucky. All items had been reviewed and specified by the Rand Memorial Hospital. That container finally shipped in December and arrived in early February. Contents were estimated to be worth around \$160,000. We also paid \$3,281 for shipping expenses.

We were also informed of a Dr. Flynn on the west coast of Florida who wanted to donate & ship a complete operating suite of equipment. That too arrived in GBI in February, and was valued at \$50,000. \$2133.77 from the funds in Freeport were used to pay some shipping expenses.

The bulk of the funds remaining were then wired to 4 companies who had been selected by the Purchasing Committee as the best sources of a list of equipment deemed most needed at Rand Memorial. A special tax exemption status was obtained to eliminate any added VAT expenses. A quick recap includes:

Bahamas Medical – A partial payment of \$66,462.04 in April and a final payment of \$20,995.83 from us & \$45,466.23 from the Bahamian funds in July for a total of \$132,924.10.

Moore's Builders – A payment of \$150,360 in April

Ports International – A payment of \$27211.20 in April

Tangent Medical – A payment of \$15,614.04 in July

Moore's Builders – A payment of \$20,830.00 in August

Please see the schedule of equipment that follows for a list of what equipment was purchased.

That leaves a meager August balance of \$465.89 remaining from our total funds of \$362,320. Most likely, it will go towards the purchase of a plaque to commemorate this incredible project.

First of all I would like to thank PDG Alan Cohn, our District 6990 Foundation Chair for the original inspirations and directions that got this project started. And, I must also graciously thank Past R.I. President Barry Rassin of Nassau for all of his support for our project.

In a rare time of scarce funds from Rotary International, it is important to thank Miami Rotary President Robert Bull and his Board for believing in me. To the Miami Rotary Foundation Board, it was extremely generous for you to agree to match at first \$100,000, and then raise it to \$125,000 to help fund this project. Maybe more Rotary Clubs should think that way going forward.

In that vein, I should also add that not one dollar of R.I. money was used in the completion of this project. And no cadre of Global Grant inspectors had to fly to GBI and count beds while sipping an "umbrella beverage".

I am also most thankful to our Miami Rotary members from Northern Trust who carefully manage our Foundation's investments, Scott Richey, Angela Deggs and Amelia Bonilla. From getting us the income over the last few years to make this \$125,000 match possible, to planning cash reserves to meet our disbursement schedules and to doing all that is necessary to wire the funds to our vendors, you all were great!

I am just glad that we were able to accomplish this Project GBI Rx that should really help the Rand Memorial Hospital in Freeport get back up and running. From what began as a local \$200,000 "district" project, we ended with an amazing project that attracted both national & international contributions, the overall impact amounting to over \$500,000!

*Never ever underestimate the generosity and the abilities of Rotarians!*
