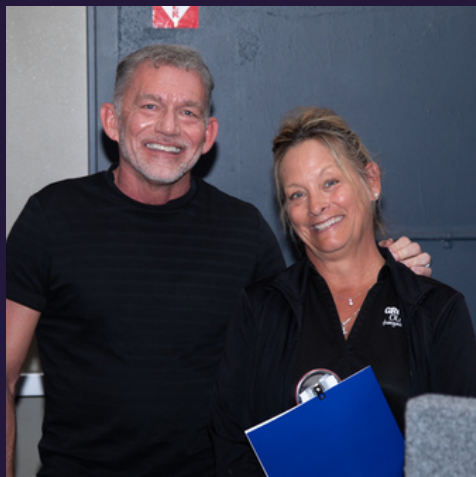

I was in the lollipop guild in a Wizard of Oz play at the Woodland Opera House.

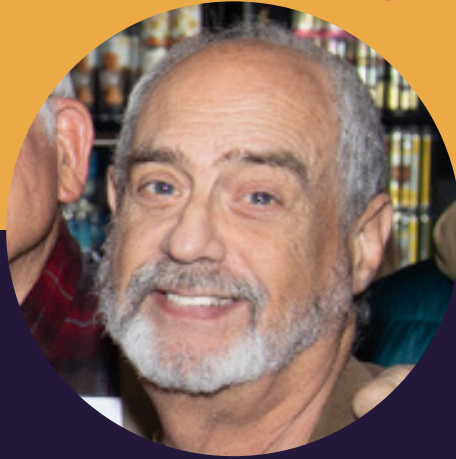
What is your favorite part of Rotary?
