Step 2

Step 3

Prospective Member is announced in at least two issues of the Club newsletter. Members have the opportunity to raise questions, concerns, or objections related to the *Proposed Member*. Upon affirmative Board vote, taking into consideration input from members, the *Prospective Member* may become a *Proposed Member*.

Step 4

Proposed Member must attend three regular club meetings (includes first meeting as interested guest), and attend one club service project, and pay pro-rated dues for the current Rotary year.

Step 5

When application is approved and requirements have been met, the *Proposed Member* will be scheduled for induction into the Club as a Member. Lunch at the induction meeting for the new member is compliments of the club. Following official induction, the new Member will be added to the Club's Roster and submitted to Rotary International.
