Step 2

Step 3

Prospective Member is announced in at least two issues of the Club newsletter. Members have the opportunity to raise questions, concerns, or objections related to the *Proposed Member*. Upon affirmative Board vote, taking into consideration input from members, the *Prospective Member* may become a *Proposed Member*.

Step 4

Proposed Member must attend three regular club meetings (includes first meeting as interested guest), and attend one club service project, and pay pro-rated dues for the current Rotary year.

Step 5

When application is approved and requirements have been met, the *Proposed Member* will be scheduled for induction into the Club as a Member.
