Program: Dr. John Noe, Mexico Service Project



John Noe is a member of the Rotary Club of Walnut Grove. He and others of their club have been traveling to El Barril, Mexico, to serve the community by performing dental procedures. They have been travelling to this remote Baja location for 13 years. It is a 1700 mile round trip and takes over 23 hours to drive one way. To assist in reaching this fishing village on the Sea of

Cortez, some members and supplies are flown in by using three airplanes. The rest of supplies are brought in via pickup truck. The clinic works with the bare essentials: there is no electricity; everything is run off of generators. Lawn chairs serve as dental chairs and scuba dive lights are used to enable the dentist to see. A portable x-ray machine allows the dentist to review potential problems that may exist. One common procedure is the pulling teeth. On their last trip, the team was able to see 42 patients. Unfortunately, they had to pull 21 teeth. A recent hurricane has destroyed many of the buildings in El Barril. The clinic was given access to a local estate for use. This worked out well for them in that the estate had air conditioning. Locals travel from throughout the area to been seen by a dentist. They showed their appreciate to the team by serving the volunteers dinners of fresh fish tacos, beans and rice.




