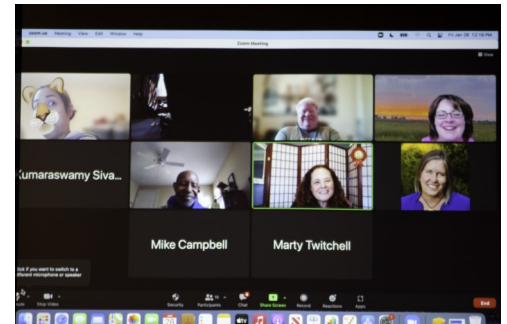

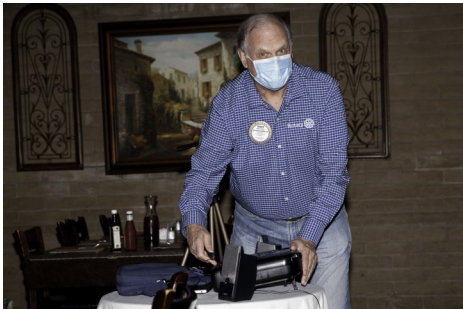

OPENING REMARKS: "This Week in History January 22nd—January 28th"

- 1962 – The Beatles signed a management contract with Brian Epstein at Brian' office, we was to receive 25% of their gross earnings at a time when the standard arrange-ment for a management contact was only 10%. All four members of the band signed the agreement, but Brian refused to sign because he had not yet fulfilled his promise to get them a record deal and withheld his signature until he had proven himself
- 1963 – Skeeter Davis hit the top 100 with The End of The World (#2). Her biggest of 8 career charters
- 1966 – Frank Sinatra's daughter Nancy hit the top 100 with These Boots Are Made For Walkin'. The song Walked its way to #1
- 1970 – Judy Collins testifying at the trial of The Chicago Seven was denied permission to sing her testimony
- 1970 – The Mini-Moog synthesizer was introduced by it's inventor Robert Moog.
- 1976 – The Donny and Marie Show premiered on ABC-TV it ran for three years and 57 episodes
- 1977 – Peter Green, one of the founding members of Fleetwood Mac, was committed to a mental institution after he attacked an accountant with an Air Rifle when the latter was attempting to deliver a \$30,000 royalty check. Green didn't want it.
- And the number one song in 1966 – Sounds of Silence by Simon and Garfunkel

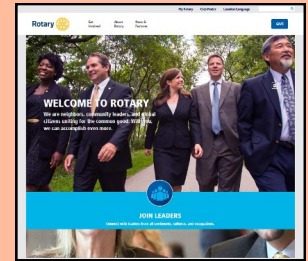
