

# Our Program: Jesse Salinas Yolo County Assessor/ Clerk-Recorder/ Registrar of Voters

The Yolo County Board of Supervisors consolidated three previously separate functions to create the "A.C.E." (Auditor/ Controller/ Elections) position to oversee recorder, registrar of voters, and tax assessor duties. Consolidation integrates the responsibilities of these compatible areas into one more efficient office.

The Assessor is responsible for appraisals of all real and personal property in the County, except public utility property, which is appraised by the State Board of Equalization. The Assessor maintains records on business and real property



characteristics and sales. Annually the Assessor prepares the local assessment roll identifying each property, the ownership, and the net taxable value.

Clerk-Recorder functions deal with property title and transfers, as well as other important vital records such as birth, marriage and death certificates. All elections activities within Yolo County, including registration, voter guides, oversight of polling places and elections returns, are managed by the Registrar of Voters.
