Program: Commander Ted Robinson, World War II Veteran



Ted Robinson served in the United States Navy during World War II. He skippered a PT boat in the South Pacific and served along side John F. Kennedy. Following the battle of Guadalcanal Ted was one of a handful of survivors able to pass his physical and continue to serve. He was sent to amphibious training and

put in charge of LSTs. Ted saw action at Saipan and Okinawa. Following the Japanese surrender he was stationed in Tokyo. When a typhoon approached Japan, Ted took his LST out to sea, but the ship's propeller became damaged when it struck a submarine net. Due to an odd set of circumstances, the damage to the ship may have saved it; 36 other ships were lost in the storm. Ted returned to Tokyo to have his ship repaired at a Japanese naval base. Ted was then put in change of the base, one of the largest in Japan. During his stay in Japan, Ted started to understand the Japanese people. The Japanese civilians were treated harshly by their own military. He started helping the citizens by providing them with food and medical care. Most of the Japanese did not even have a place to sleep since homes were destroyed from bombings. The people began to appreciate his actions, and Ted went from hating the "enemy" to a feeling of compassion. His entire viewpoint changed as a result of his postwar experiences.

FIRST: The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service;


