# Our Program: Sacramento Food Bank Genevieve Levy

Genevieve Levy, Director of Family Services for the Sacramento Food Bank, brought an informative presentation on the history and current services of her non-profit agency to our Club. The Food Bank was founded in 1976 by Father Dan Madigan of the Immaculate Conception Church, who made many appearances at our Club over the years. Since then, it has grown to a staff of 86 and expanded services well beyond food distribution.

Assisted by an annual volunteer force of over 9,940, the Food Bank provides free emergency goods and services to 140,000 men, women and children each

month. In 2014, they merged with the Senior Gleaners, creating a more sustainable model for distributing food to low-income people. Along with food distribution, they provide clothing, adult, parent, and youth education, immigration legal services and refugee resettlement services.




