These services include: access to food, income tax assistance, insurance enrollment and navigation, childcare facility matching, and early childhood development and education opportunities. Katie highlighted the Play School Experience, a weekly opportunity for kids to "bond and enjoy quality time with your child and other parents through dun and educational activities aimed at promoting children's early development and enhancing readiness for school. 


