Dr. Dawnte Early-West is on the MHSOAC (Mental Health Services Oversight & Accountability Committee.)

The proposition 63 The Mental Health Service Act passed by voters increased taxes on wealthy inividuals to pay for mental health issues. This revenue funds nearly 25% of the state mental health system. This is \$2 Billion of the total \$8 Billion state budget for public mental health. The Funding flows through the state to the county level where it is applied in innovative ways to reduce some of the problems caused by mental health issues. 5% of this money goes to support state operations and a variety of agencies and 95% is designated for local mental health agencies. Of this 95%, 80% is for community services, and 20% for prevention and early intervention programs. These local funds spend 5% of their funding for innovating new ideas. Yolo County currently spends about \$10 Million of the MHSA revenue.

The goal of the mental health programs are to minimize problems such as suicide, unemployment, Incarceration, homelessness, school dropouts, removal of kids from homes, and prolonged suffering.
