Rotary's Areas of Focus:

Rotary's 34,000 clubs and 1.2 million members serve communities around the world, each with unique concerns and needs. Rotarians have continually adapted and improved the way they respond to those needs, taking on a broad range of service projects. The most successful and sustainable Rotary service tends to fall within one of the following seven areas:

- Peace and conflict prevention/resolution
- Disease prevention and treatment
- Water and sanitation
- Material and child health
- Basic education and literacy
- Economic and community development
- Protecting the environment

Guidelines:

The Rotary Club of Healdsburg intends to encompass these six areas of focus when considering service projects and requests for donations from other organizations. With this in mind, the Rotary Club of Healdsburg has established the following guidelines for the consideration of these requests:

- International projects will be considered with priority given to the following areas of interest:
 - Children and Youth
 - Literacy and Education
 - Community Quality of Life, including but not limited to clean water and health
 - Economic development, including but not limited microlending and business education
 - Requests outside of these areas will be considered when they meet needs within our community
- Projects supported or participated in by members of the Rotary Club of Healdsburg will be considered
- The following types of requests will not be considered:
 - Political fundraising, candidates, or for political purposes
 - Programs that promote religion
 - Programs that limit diversity or inclusion
 - Private foundations
 - Ongoing operating expenses
 - Salaries, benefits or administrative costs of start-up programming
 - A fundraising event that benefits one individual

Proposals:

All proposals must be submitted in writing.

Donation requests will be considered by the "International Committee" and then submitted, with their recommendations, to the board of directors for final consideration. In some cases, the organization requesting a donation may be asked to make a presentation at a weekly meeting of the club to educate the membership about their project or program.
