

## PROGRAM

Craft Talk by **PP John Hazlett**

**John** spent 20 years in the Air Force as a navigator in B-52 Bombers. His job was to get the bomber wherever it needed to be within a 2-minute window. The B-52 has a range of 8800 miles and travels at 420 m.p.h. at an altitude of 45,000 ft. Before a bombing run they would slow to 320 m.p.h. at an altitude of 800 ft.

John also worked on the D-21 program at area 51 in Nevada called Tagboard. The D-21 was a drone with a camera that was dropped from the bomber and then flew over China. After it took pictures of China it flew over the Pacific Ocean where it would drop its camera over the ocean. The camera would be scooped up by a C-130 and returned to a base where the pictures could be analyzed. The program was shortly cancelled.
