## PROGRAM

Today's speakers were **Ariel Kelley and her team (named above)**, whose topic was Corazon Healdsburg. They manage 10 programs for low income families. Interestingly, Corazon means heart in Spanish! There are 3 facets to their mission: Comunidad, La Voz, and Casa Del Corazon, which is a family resource center. One program is called "Moms to Moms Prenatal Education." They also participate in the Dolly Parton Imagination Library (as do we). They sponsor adult education programs, such as GED, which are taught by the SRJC or Catholic Charities. Corazon Comite is a committee of active engaged Healdsburg Latino residents. They sponsor the Healdsburg Kinder2College Fund, which started with seed money from the Ellen DeGeneres Show.

Additionally, they sponsor the First Gen College Counseling, which targets the first generation in the family to go to a 4-year college. They also sponsor community events, such as the annual Dia de los Muertos, or Day of the Dead, coming soon to Healdsburg Plaza.
